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### HAIRSTYLING

Scope document

Post Secondary

Friday, April 3rd – Woodford’s Training Centre, CBS

*Note: One competitor per registered school*

**Duration of Contest: 6 hrs.**

### PURPOSE OF THE CHALLENGE

To enable industry as well as observers to view the level of skills taught within the public, secondary and post-secondary programs and to encourage interaction between the various sectors. This relationship will ensure the skills gained by young hairstylists at all levels of training are geared to the demands of the beauty industry.

### SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO BE TESTED

The level of this competition will allow the young stylists to demonstrate their technical skills and creative ability in the following three tests:

1. Men’s Classical Sculptured Cut (Bombage) and Style with Beard Design
2. Ladies Consumer Day Style with Color Enhancement
3. Ladies Hair By Night with Hairpieces and Ornamentation

No written test will be administered. The theoretical knowledge will be relevant in the performance of the practical tests.

#### TEST #1 – MEN’S HAIRSTYLING CLASSICAL SCULPTURED CUT (BOMBAGE) & STYLE WITH BEARD DESIGN

**Time limit: 3 hrs**

*This competition calls for sculpting an overall square shape. Necklines and sides are traditionally tapered and graduated. This is also classified as a formal cut, using very precise skills in haircutting. Hair color will not be changed.*

#### Haircut:

- All cutting tools are allowed, except for clipper attachments
- The neckline is tapered to zero just above the collar line

#### Finished style:

- Only hand held dryers may be used
- No other thermal tools allowed
- All brushes and/or combs are permitted
- All styling products are permitted

#### Beard Design:

- All cutting tools are allowed

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- Clipper attachments are **not** allowed
- Creative Beard Design

### Criteria(marking scheme)

- Originality 5
- Skills in Mustache & Beard 5
- Cutting and Styling Techniques 5
- Cleanliness of finish 5
- Presentation 5

### TEST #2 – LADIES HAIRSTYLING

#### LADIES CONSUMER DAY STYLE (TO BE CONVERTED INTO A COCKTAIL STYLE IN TEST #3)

*Time limit: 1.5 hours*

*A day style will be displayed, as performed in the high fashion salons, following international trends. Color and form must not be extreme.*

#### Haircut:

- The style is of the competitor's own choice but should follow the international trends (*Competing to Win* from **Pivot Point** is a great reference)

#### Color:

- You **must** color the hair **before** the competition but the color will be marked with the cut
- All color techniques are allowed
- The choice of the color is free, but without being extreme; it must remain within a commercial color range
- No solid primary, secondary, or full-head colors are allowed
- No color sprays, gels or mousses are allowed

**The hairpieces for test #3 MUST be colored and/or cut and set with either rollers, pins or clips, but not dressed or finished, before this test.(Must be dry before next competition)**

#### Blow – Dry:

- The competitors must perform a blow-dry only, on wet hair
- All tools allowed except thermal tools
- All finishing products are allowed except color spray, gel or mousse
- All hairpieces, wigs and extensions are forbidden

### Criteria (marking scheme)

- Balance & form 5
- Cleanliness of finish 5
- Originality of design 5
- Color enhancement 5
- Artistic impression 5

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### TEST #3 – LADIES HAIRSTYLING

#### LADIES HAIR BY NIGHT WITH HAIRPIECES AND ORNAMENTATION

**Time limit: 1.5 hours**

The competitor will use the Day Style from test #2 to transform into Hair by Night with the addition of longer hair and ornamentation.

#### **Finished Style:**

- This competition is an elegant evening style
- The mannequin from test #2 remains on the floor, unchanged
- The competitor must thoroughly brush the whole head when given the order
- Competitors can, if they wish, wet, shape, blowdry or style the hair
- Longer hair must be integrated in order to emphasize the fashionable evening character, but also in order to present a new, longer appearing style (minimum of 2 hairpieces, maximum of 3 hairpieces)
- The hairpieces are taken to the competition floor from test #2, set and dried, on either rollers, pins or clips, but not dressed
- The hairpieces cannot cover more than 50% of the whole head
- Ornaments made from hair or hair-like fibers are forbidden

#### Criteria (marking scheme)

- Balance & form 5
- Cleanliness 5
- Originality of design 5
- Hairpieces integration 5
- Ornamentation 5

#### **Career related Skills exhibited:**

1. Haircutting – scissors, razor, texturizer, clippers
2. Hairstyling – setting, blow-drying
3. Long Hair Design
4. Creative Cosmetology/Ornamentation
5. Hair Coloring and De-Coloration – semi-permanent and permanent
6. Competition Styling
7. Beard Design

#### **EQUIPMENT, TOOLS, SUPPLIES, CLOTHING**

##### **Contestants must provide for competition**

- Clean and comfortable work attire as would be worn by staff working in a modern hair salon as well as any protective clothing if needed
- Smocks and gloves must be worn when coloring
- Their own working tools; water bottle, towels, cape, cutting implements, combs, brushes, clips, blow dryer, gloves
- Colors and styling products

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- Must bring his/her preferred types of products and color products with **all labels fully covered**
- Must provide make-up, jewelry, draping and hair ornamentation for the mannequin
- One mannequin head support (with extensions or tripod)
- Contestants cannot borrow supplies from others
- Hair dryer must not require more than 1800 watts
- Curling irons must be 125v; 75 amp

### **Supplied by committee:**

Each contestant will be provided with a table, mirror, non-hydraulic chair and double electrical outlet.

### **MANNEQUINS MUST BE SUPPLIED BY THE COMPETITOR**

Two competition mannequins – one ladies mannequin and one male mannequins (with full beard)  
Mannequins shall be of competition grade with shoulders

### **JUDGING:**

- All judging will be performed according to the criteria
- The contestants with the highest combined points from the three tests will be the winner, the second highest mark will be placed second and the third highest mark will be placed third
- Demerits may be given for any rule infractions

*Any communication between audience and competitor during contests times may be seen as coaching and could cause demerits to be awarded or disqualification*

### **Penalty points**

Length – 1 point

Color – 1 point

Use of tools – 1 point

Out of category – 1 point

Coaching – first warning will incur 1-5 points

- second warning will be disqualification

No head sets, walkmans or portable CD players allowed.

No technical support such as formulas, pictures, drawings, notes, etc.

Absolutely **NO** cutting of mannequins prior to competition – could result in disqualifications

Demerits will be awarded – First warning 1 – 5; Second warning – disqualification

### **Health and Safety Industry standards must be followed throughout the competition**

### **Notice to trainers & participants:**

In the event of a tie in scoring, the following procedure will apply:

1. In the event of a tie, the candidate with the highest score in the “Ladies Cosumer Day Style w/color Enhancement” competition will be declared the winner.
2. In the event of a tie in the “Ladies Consumer Day Style w/color Enhancement” competition, the candidate with the highest score in the “Mens Classical Sculptured Cut (Bombage)” competition will be declared the winner.
